(TORONTO – February 1, 2021) The Toronto Smartphone Film Festival (TSFF) is accepting early-bird submissions for its 9th festival, "TSFF 2021 Reimagined," until February 7, 2021.

The deadlines and fees for submission guidelines are as follows:

- Early-Bird (\$10): Sunday, February 7, 2021, at 11:59 p.m. EST
- Regular (\$15): Sunday, March 14, 2021, at 11:59 p.m. EST
- Late (\$20): Sunday, April 4, 2021, at 11:59 p.m. EST
